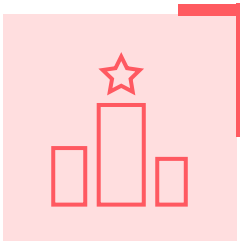

Can't get treatment on the NHS?

We understand that it is becoming increasingly difficult to receive IVF treatment through the NHS which means that many women and couples have been left with little choice due to being priced out of the private treatment. Depending on the area you live in, the amount of IVF funding available on the NHS varies considerably. In some areas, IVF funding has been cut altogether.

If you live in an area where the NHS has cut IVF funding, have used up all your funding or are tired of the long waiting lists for treatment; *abc ivf* should be your next point of call.

Refused IVF on the NHS because of strict criteria?

You may have been refused IVF treatment on the NHS due to:

- Already having a child
- Your partner already having a child
- Lifestyle factors, such as body weight and smoking
- Having not been trying naturally for over 2 years
- Not meeting age criteria

In 2017, *Fertility Fairness* found that the number of clinical commissioning groups (CCGs) in England offering the recommended 3 IVF cycles to eligible women under 40, halved in the previous 5 years. Just 12% of CCGs now follow national guidance.

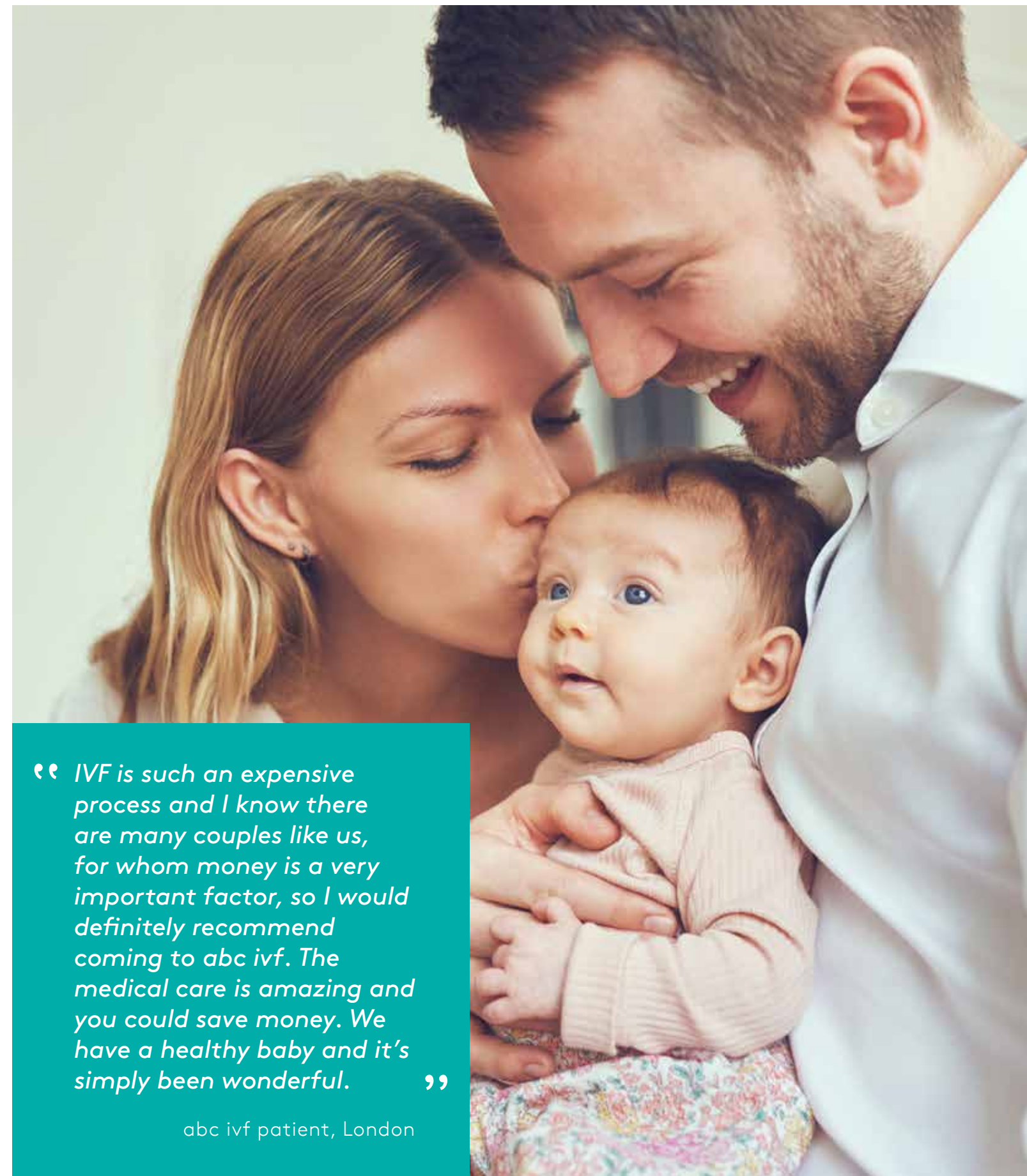

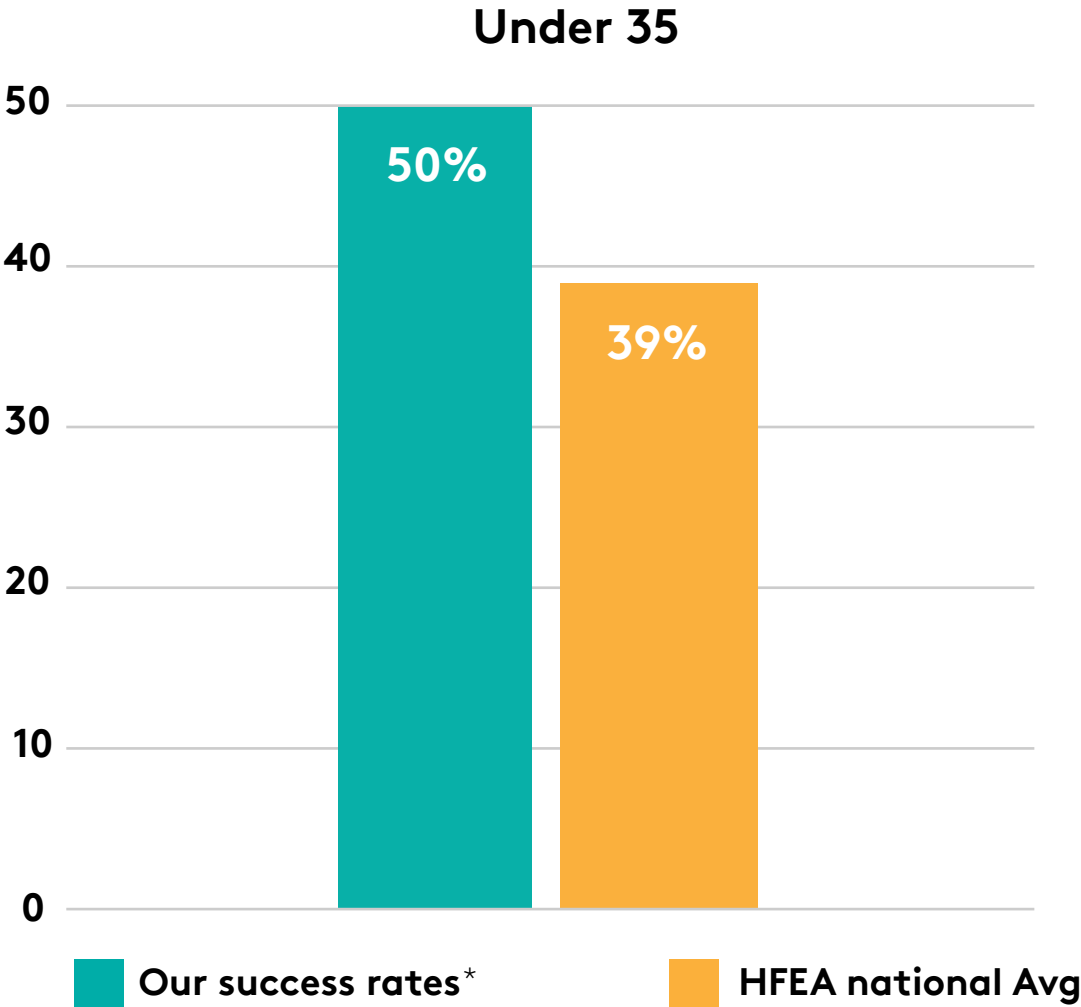

Donor sperm

The cost of donor sperm varies and is payable directly to the sperm bank. You should estimate between £750 and £1,000 to purchase donor sperm (excluding courier fees).

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- In specific cases there may be the need for additional treatments that are not included within our cycle packages and charged separately. Exact costs will be discussed at consultation based on patients’ individual needs. Examples include;
- **Male factor:** If you have a fertility issue due to a male factor, you may require additional support and treatments such as ICSI.
 - **Egg & Embryo Freezing:** In specific cases that may be a medical need to freeze embryos. You may require embryo freezing, Cryo-storage and potentially a Frozen Embryo Transfer (FET) procedure.
 - **Diagnostic tests:** In certain situations and clinician could request that you have further diagnostic testing. The reasons will be clearly explained to you.

abc Terms and Conditions

We are leading experts in IVF with a good track record. However, no provider of fertility treatment services is able to guarantee a successful outcome or an absence of complications. Accordingly, we are unable to give a commitment that any fertility treatment that you undertake will lead to a pregnancy and/or will be without complications.

Please also note that we reserve the right at any time to determine in our clinical discretion that you or any person on whose behalf you are acting is not suitable for treatment by **abc IVF**.

OUR TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Prices and Payment

Paying for freezing and storage: In the event that a clinician recommends elective freezing for your cycle due to your individual medical circumstances, you will be required to pay for freezing and storage. For situations where 1-2 embryos require freezing for a maximum of 3 months (from date of egg collection) the cost is £395. If multiple embryos/longer storage term is required, the cost of £995 for freezing and storage for 2 years applies. In these circumstances you are entitled to a discount of £400 from standard clinic pricing for your frozen embryo transfer (FET). To receive the discounted price all treatments must be paid in full before treatment commences.

Payment Plan Terms: If you opt to pay for your treatment through our finance scheme you are bound by the terms and conditions of that agreement. The initial treatment costs were estimated at the time of your initial consultation based on an assumed level of medication, scans and tests based on your personal circumstances. As with any medical treatment, this may vary depending on how your treatment is progressing and may need to be adjusted. If you require additional medication, blood tests and treatments above the estimate they are chargeable at the standard retail price at the time of purchase. Unfortunately additional cost items cannot be added to your finance plan and need to be funded separately.

Freezing and Storage - Egg / embryo freezing and storage is an additional service outside of those included within the cycle package and will be chargeable at our standard rates.

Medication: The medication included in the price of your cycle includes Bemfola, Cetrotide, Ovitrelle and Utrogestan. The amount given per cycle can vary depending on your personal situation and this will be decided by the clinician. The amount of Utrogestan is limited to 2 boxes. If you need any other medication in addition to this, you will need to pay an additional amount above the base cycle price.

Prescription: Medication that is not included in the package price that may be required (for example: additional medication required for your cycle (see below); for Frozen Embryo Transfers or for post pregnancy test medication) is available to purchase from the clinic. However if you would prefer to purchase medication from an alternative pharmacy, a small cost is charged for the administration involved in raising a private prescription.

Initial Consultation

You must make full payment when you make your booking for an Initial Consultation. You may need to undertake certain diagnostic tests before your Initial Consultation. Once you have made a booking we will send you various consent forms which you will need to bring with you to the Initial Consultation.

Cancellation fees which will apply if you decide not to go ahead with a Initial Consultation and do not reschedule:

- If you cancel more than 72 hours before your Initial Consultation without rescheduling we will refund you your fee less a £50 administration fee
- If you cancel less than 72 hours but more than 48 hours before your Initial Consultation we will refund you 50% of your fee
- If you cancel less than 48 hours before your Initial Consultation you will not receive any refund of your fee

Rescheduling fees which will apply if you reschedule an Initial Consultation:

- If you reschedule more than 48 hours before your Initial Consultation there will be no cancellation charge
- If you reschedule less than 48 hours before your Initial Consultation we will charge a £25 administration fee.

Where we retain some or all of your fees when you cancel or reschedule it is because we have incurred administrative costs in arranging your Initial Consultation.

Refunds in any other circumstances: if we decide for any other reason not to proceed with the Initial Consultation then we will be entitled to retain fees to cover our administrative costs. Please see our terms for further details

Treatment Consultation

The treatment plan consultation includes a full treatment review and consent check with a clinician.

You will need to pay a deposit of £500 at the time of making your booking if you wish to go ahead with fertility treatments. The remainder is payable at your treatment plan consultation.

Once you have made a booking we will send you various consent forms which you will need to bring with you to the Initial Consultation.

Cancellation fees which will apply if you decide not to go ahead with a treatment plan consultation and do not reschedule:

- If you cancel more than 5 days before your treatment plan consultation without rescheduling we will refund you:
 - £200 of your deposit if you have undergone the screening tests
 - All of your deposit if you have not undergone the screening tests
- If you cancel less than 5 days before your treatment plan consultation we will, at our discretion, be entitled to keep all of your deposit even if you have not undergone the screening tests. We will always act reasonably in deciding whether to keep your deposit.

Rescheduling fees which will apply if you reschedule a treatment plan consultation:

- If you reschedule more than 5 days before your treatment plan consultation there will be no cancellation charge
- If you reschedule less than 5 days before your treatment plan consultation we will, at our discretion, be entitled to make a cancellation charge. We will always act reasonably in deciding this.

Refund policy: once you have had your treatment plan consultation we only offer refunds in the following circumstances:

- If you decide not to proceed with treatment at the Clinic or immediately following a treatment plan consultation we will refund £2,250. We will keep our £500 deposit to cover treatment plan consultation and screening test costs.
- If you decide not to proceed with treatment following a treatment plan consultation and after you have been dispensed medication we will refund £1,500. We will keep our £500 deposit to cover treatment plan consultation and screening test costs. We will also keep £750 to cover medication costs.
- If we decide, in our clinical discretion, that you are not suitable for treatment or we decide not to treat you for any other reason following a treatment plan consultation, we will refund your fee minus our £500 deposit to cover treatment plan consultation and screening test costs and (if applicable) £750 to cover medications dispensed.
- If a cycle is abandoned by you or us prior to egg collection we will refund your total fees less our £500 deposit, £750 to cover medication and treatment plan consultation fees and:
 - Where the cycle is interrupted we charge £200 per scan
- If we decide for any other reason not to proceed with a treatment plan consultation or treatment then we will be entitled to retain fees to cover our administrative costs. Please see our terms for further details.

We regret that at the time of egg collection, if no egg/eggs are collected, no refund will be issued and if no embryo is transferred there will also be no refund.

Embryo and egg freezing services are excluded from fertility treatment packages. Please see below for details of our services and prices.

Additional Services

- Costs for additional scans, other laboratory tests and additional procedures can vary depending on your clinical need and your response to treatment. Any additional services will be chargeable at our standard rates.
